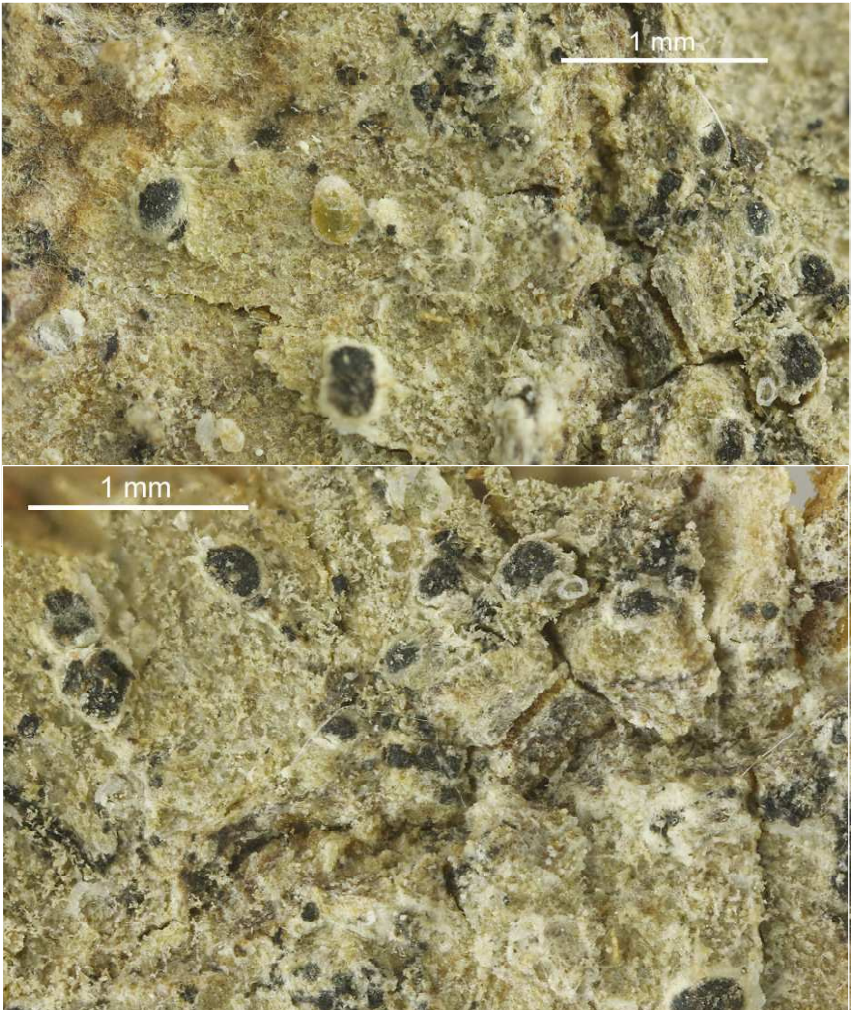


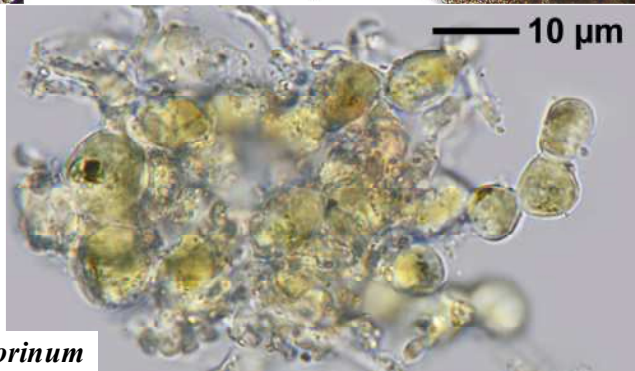
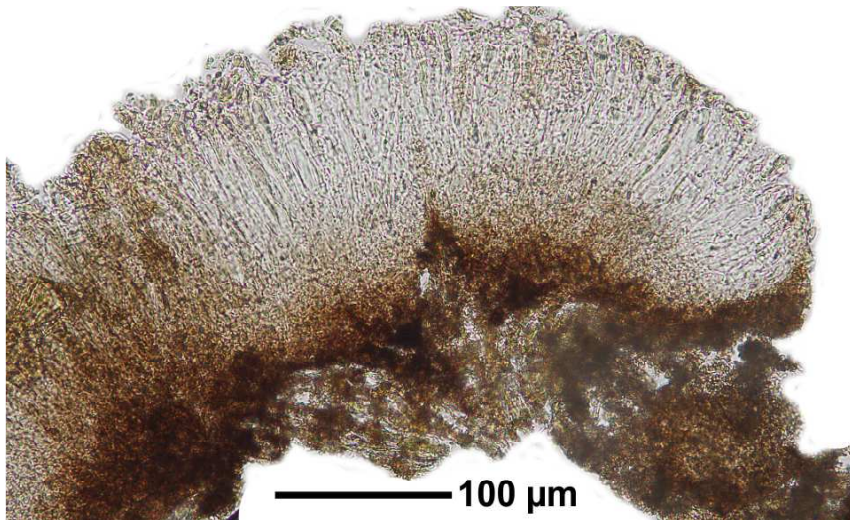
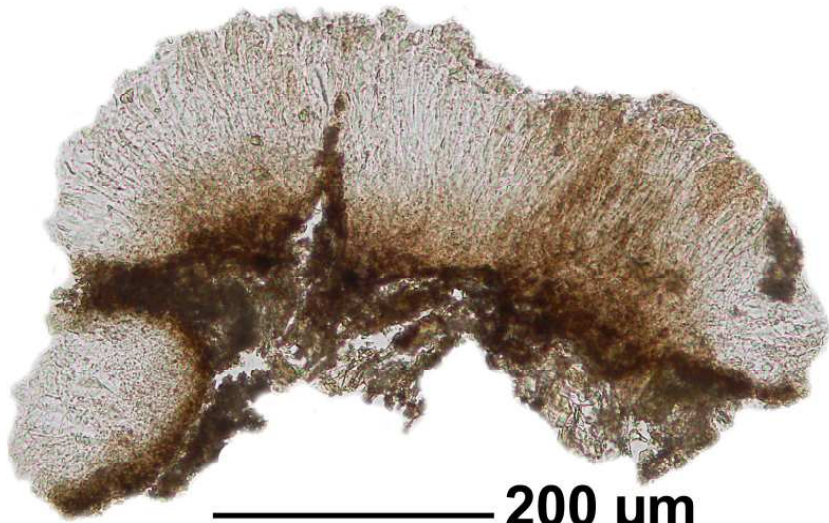
Chiodecton mucorinum Zahlbr.

Thallus greyish green, smooth to verruculose. Ascocarps solitary or rarely united, aggregated into stroma-like structures. Hamathecium not interspersed, J+ red. Paraphysoids strongly branched, reticulate. Hypothecium brownish, in K greenish. Asci J-. Ascospores 6-10 septate, 35-50 x 2-3 μm . Chemistry: K-, C-, P-, UV- (margin of ascocarps white), roccellic acid.

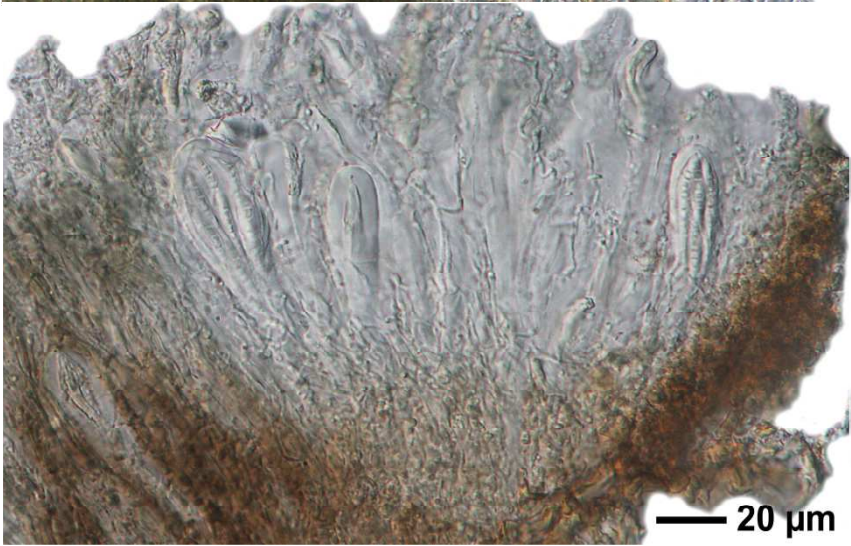
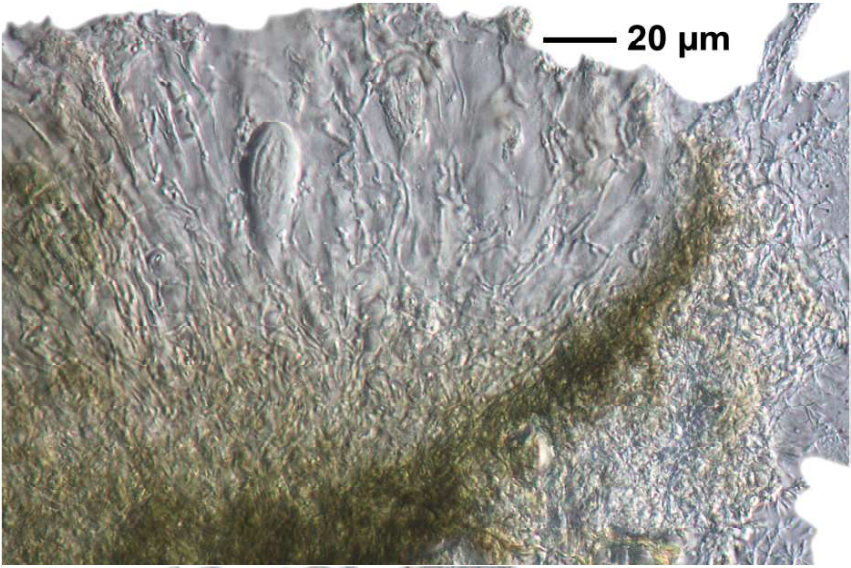
