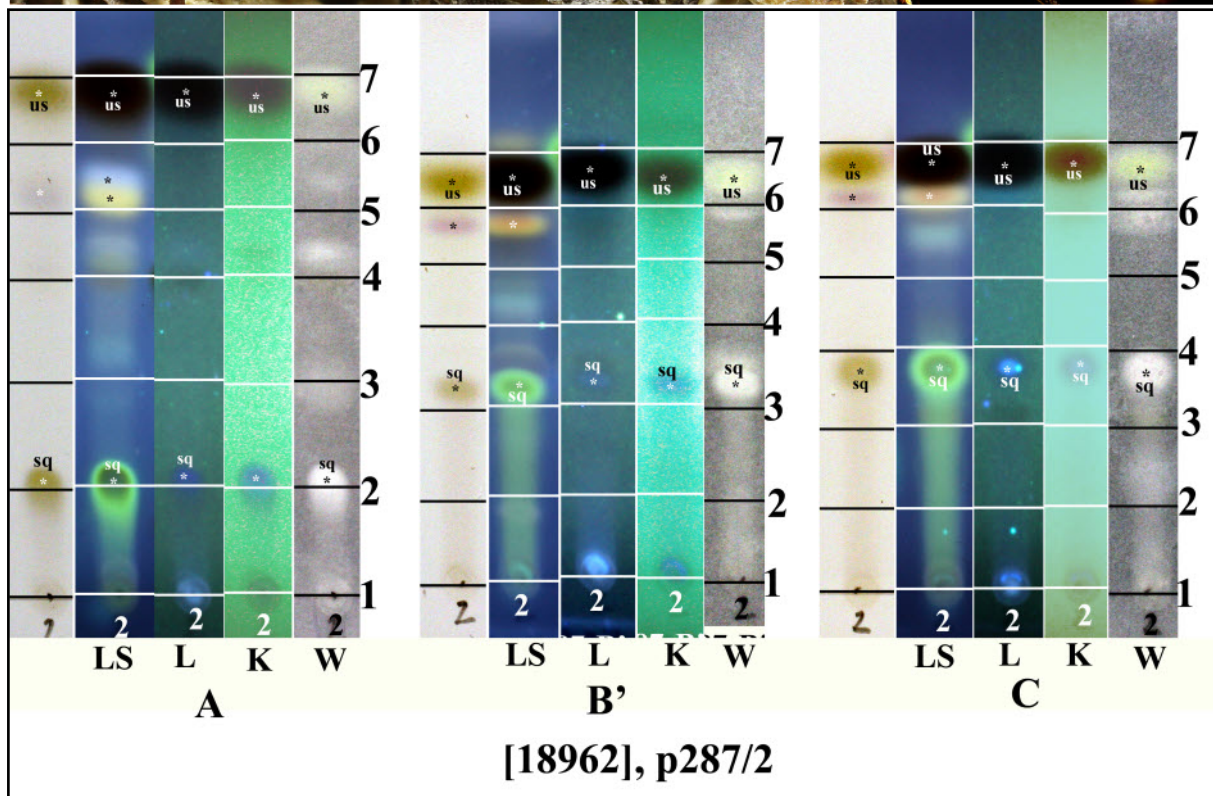


Cladonia capitellata (Hook.f. & Taylor) C.Bab. var. *squamatica*

Distinguished from var. *capitellata* by containing squamatic acid, rather than thamnolic acid.

[18962], Australia, New South Wales, Southern Tablelands, Tinderry Mountains, 9 km ESE of Michelago, 35°45' S, 149°15' E, 1250 m, over bryophytes and litter on granite outcrop with *Leptospermum* scrub in open subalpine eucalypt woodland. Leg. J. Johnston (2518), 9.09.1987 (CANB).
