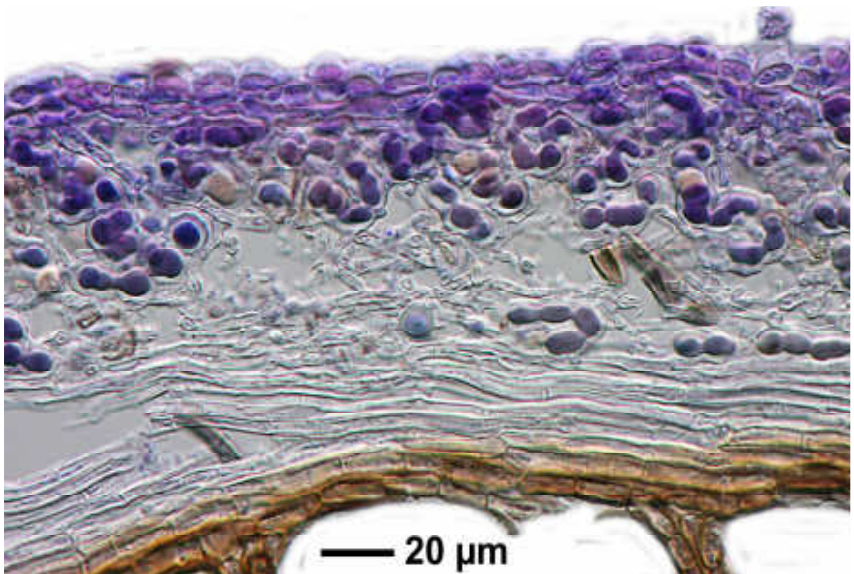


Coccocarpia smaragdina Pers.

Thallus grey to bluish grey, not zonate, not isidiate, without soralia; lobes 0.5-0.7 cm wide, surface distinctly white pruinose, especially towards lobe apices; margins of lobes deflexed; lower surface cream to black, densely rhizinate. Apothecia adnate, 1-4 mm, yellowish brown. Spores fusiform, hyaline, 8/ascus, 1-locular, young with plasmatic appendices, 7-13 x 3-5 μm . Chemistry: K-, C-, KC-, P-, UV-; TLC: nil.
