

Leptogium cyanescens (Rabenh.) Körb.

Thallus flat, c. 3 mm broad, 70-100 μm thick, dull grey-blue, with tere-
te or occasionally \pm flattened isidia. Surface matt or somewhat shining,
smooth or occasionally roughened, never wrinkled. Apothecia very
rare, with narrow, \pm isidiate margin; proper exipulum of periclinal
hyphae. Spores muriform, (15-)19-23(-25) x (6-)7-9(-10) μm , 8/ascus.
Algae: *Nostoc* mainly in clusters. Cosmopolitan.
