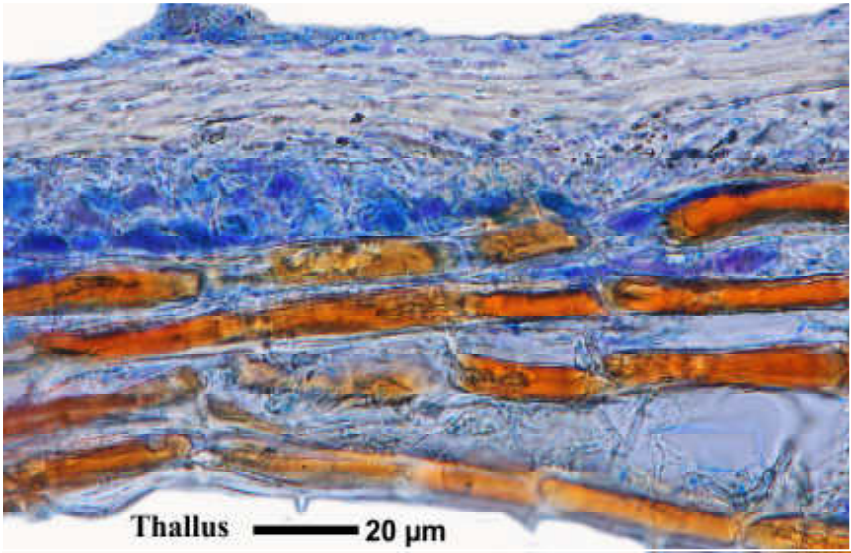


Pyrenula aspistea (Afzel.) Ach.

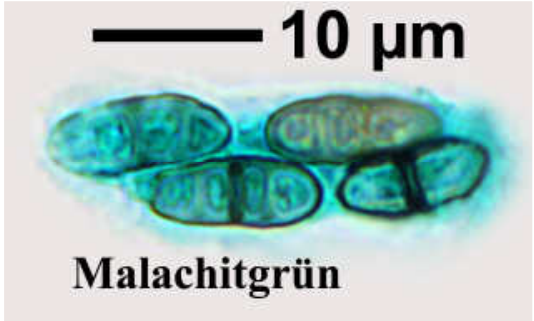
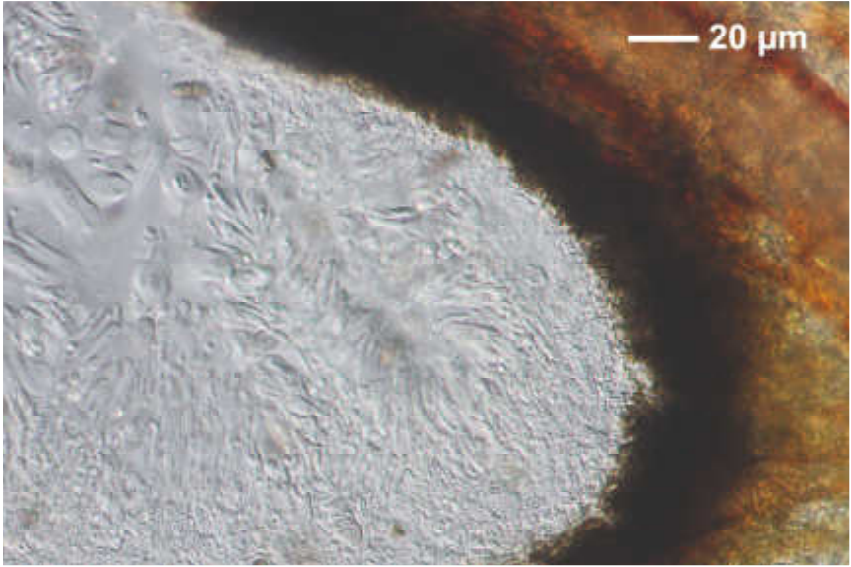
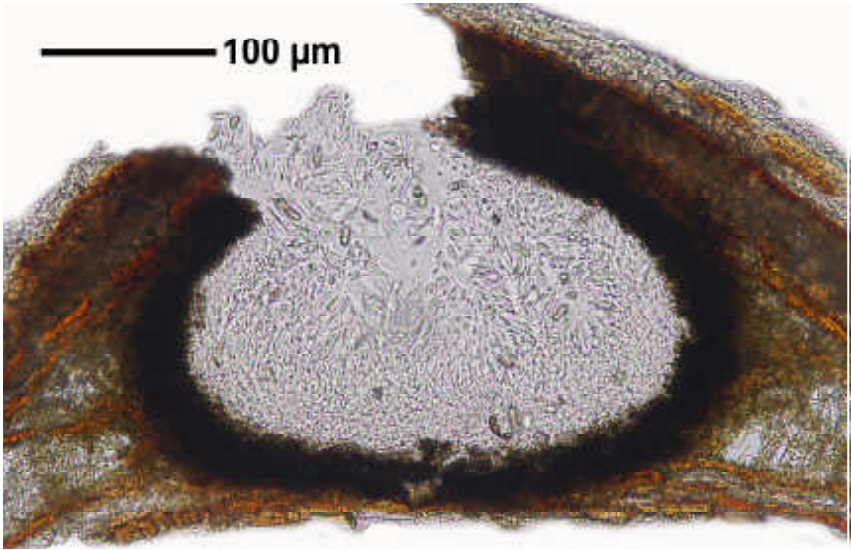
Thallus corticated, brownish to olive greenish, without pseudocyphellae. Perithecia single, flattened to conical, laterally covered often by the thallus, c. 0.3-0.4 mm wide. Wall of the perithecium without crystals. Hamathecium not inspers, J-. Filaments not branched. Ascospores 8/ascus, grey brownish, 3-septate, 10-16 x 5-6.5 μm . Chemistry: nil.
