





Pyrenula thelemorpha Tuck.


Thallus brownish to olive-green. Perithecia single, nearly globose, lifted out of the substrate, sides covered by the thallus, c. 0.4-0.7 mm wide. Ostiolum pale. Wall of peritheciium with crystals. Hamathecium not inspersed. Filaments not branched. Ascospores grey-brown, 8/ascus, muriform, 27-45 x 11-19 μm . Chemistry: nil. Corticolous. Lit. Aptroot 2008.


